Expectations for Curriculum/Professional Group Representatives

Intermediate District 287 has a system of reviewing curriculum, considering its relationship to standards, and sharing lessons and expertise. This system involves all licensed staff who provide primary instruction. Subject or professional area groups meet three times a year to (1) learn together and (2) accomplish work related to district curriculum goals.

All staff participating in curriculum groups are expected to:

1. *Attend the sessions.*
2. *Represent their site...*
 - *by acting as the site liaison for the subject or professional area.*

At the meetings, teachers will gain information that may be necessary for others at the site to know, particularly if additional teachers teach the same subject area but are involved in other curriculum groups.
 - *by completing their site's curriculum work.*

This work is related to the group's outcomes for the year. While some of the work will be able to be accomplished within the meeting times, there is an expectation activities will be accomplished even if additional time must be spent by the representative.
3. *Represent themselves...*
 - *by using the time to network with colleagues.*
 - *by sharing classroom resources related to the subject area.*
