For the past 20+ years, Ms. Botzet has worked at the University of Minnesota, Department of Psychiatry in the Center for Adolescent Substance Abuse Research as a Project Coordinator, examining a variety of topics related to addiction. She also works as a psychotherapist seeing patients in the Office-Based Opioid Treatment (OBOT) and Substance Use Disorders (SUDz) programs in the U of MN's Psychiatry Clinic, as well as in private practice.
